József Böröcz: „**We were done away with**”. *The '56 revolution of Hungary's „Honvéd Együttes” choir in China*

One of the emblematic institutions of Stalinist cultural policy the *Honvéd Együttes* military choir spent 3.5 months in China (PRC) on the Fall of 1956.
